# 2023-24 | Mens League Rules | South Davis Recreation 

HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL RULES WILL GOVERN PLAY WITH THE FOLLOWING MODIFICATIONS:

## Team Roster Rules/Player Eligibility:

1. Players must be listed on the team roster in order to participate. Players can be added at anytime during the season and must be done with the supervisor on court BEFORE your game starts
2. Players are only allowed to play for one team in each league.
3. Players can substitute for multiple teams during the season but must play for only one team for the tournament.
4. Players must play in at least three regular season games for the same team in order to play in the tournament.
5. Teams are responsible to get their lineups to the scorekeepers 5 minutes prior to tip-off.

## Equipment:

1. A game ball will be provided by South Davis Recreation.
2. Every team must provide their own matching jerseys with numbers on the front and back.

## Game:

1. Game play will consist of two 17 minute halves with a 3 minute intermission at half time.
2. On the 7th Foul teams will automatically into doube bonus and shoot 2.
3. The clock will only stop on free throws and in the last 2 minutes of the second half.
4. If a team is winning by more than 20 points in the final two minutes of the game, the clock will run.
5. Teams must have 4 players in order to avoid a forfeit. (You will be given 5 game time minutes to field a team.)
6. Each team has 4 timeouts per game to be used at any point.
7. Players are allowed 5 personal fouls per game. Your 5th foul you will be asked to sit the remainder of the game
8. Overtime is an additonal period of play for 3 minutes with the clock stopping in the final 30 seconds. Each team will only be alotted one time out for OT. If teams are tied after a second OT period then Sudden Death will occur. The ball will be jumped at midcourt and the first team to score a basket will win the game.

## Technical/Intentional Fouls:

## 1. Dunking the ball will result in a technical foul.

2. Any behavior that breaks the code of conduct will result in a technical foul.
3. Any player who receives a technical foul will have to sit out 8 minutes of game time. If a second technical is issued then the player is ejected from the game and will be required to sit out the next game as well.
4. Any player who accumulates 3 technical fouls throughout the season will be ejected from the League.
5. Any intentional foul that puts an opposing player at serious risk of injury can result in ejection from the league.
6. Any violent behavior will result in automatic ejection from the league and banning from future leagues.
7. Any team may be issued a "Team Technical" for the behavior of the team as a whole or for the behavior of your teams spectators. Any team who recieves $\mathbf{2}$ "Team Technicals" in a game will forefit the game.

## Tournament Play:

1. At the end of the season the top 4 teams will play a single elimination tournament.
2. Only players who played in at least 3 regular season games are eligible for the tournament.
3. Players are only allowed to play for one team in the tournament. Players may be required to show photo ID.
4. Teams with a Sportsmanship score of less than 3 will not be eligible to play in the tournament.
5. Any team with $\mathbf{3}$ or more forfeits throughout the season is subject to disqualification from the tournament.

Code of Conduct: ZERO TOLERANCE FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. Questioning Referee Calls- THE CAPTAIN can respectfully ask questions to official/court supervisor

No other player may question the official. This will result in an immediate technical foul.
2. Excessive foul language or use of profanity.
3. Threats or abuse (verbal or physical).
4. Violent behavior/fighting.
5. Verbal harassment from the spectator seating area.
6. Intoxication (alcohol, marijuana, etc.), will result in forfeit of game. 2nd offense is a team ejection from the league. Spectators are expected to follow all rules and regulations both from the Recreation District and the School District. Those breaking these rules will be asked to leave the facility and/or have the police called. Any spectators who are determined to have attended a game intoxicated will be asked to leave and may be denied entry to future games/activities.
