

Sportsmanship Rules 2023 | Men's League | South Davis Recreation

Our goals & objectives are based on Competition, Skill Development, and Teamwork. If your team's goals & objectives do not align with the above, then this is not the league for your team.

SPORTSMANSHIP

This sportsmanship program is aimed to help teach and encourage good sportsmanship to players, parents and coaches participating in the South Davis League. Each game teams will receive a sportsmanship score based on five criteria, earning up to five points.

Scores will be awarded based on the following criteria:

Sportsmanship Criteria	Points	Yes/No
Team Rosters were on time and in good standing.	1	<input type="checkbox"/>
Coaches keep themselves and players under control.	1	<input type="checkbox"/>
No technical fouls or flagrant fouls called on team during the games.	1	<input type="checkbox"/>
Parents and spectators are positive during games and not harassing the officials.	1	<input type="checkbox"/>
Teams display good sportsmanship before, during, and after the game.	1	<input type="checkbox"/>

In addition to teams highest in the standings, teams must have an average of at least three sportsmanship points per game in order to make it into the end-of-season single elimination tournament. Teams highest in the standings who do not reach the three point sportsmanship average will forfeit their tournament seeding to the next best team.
