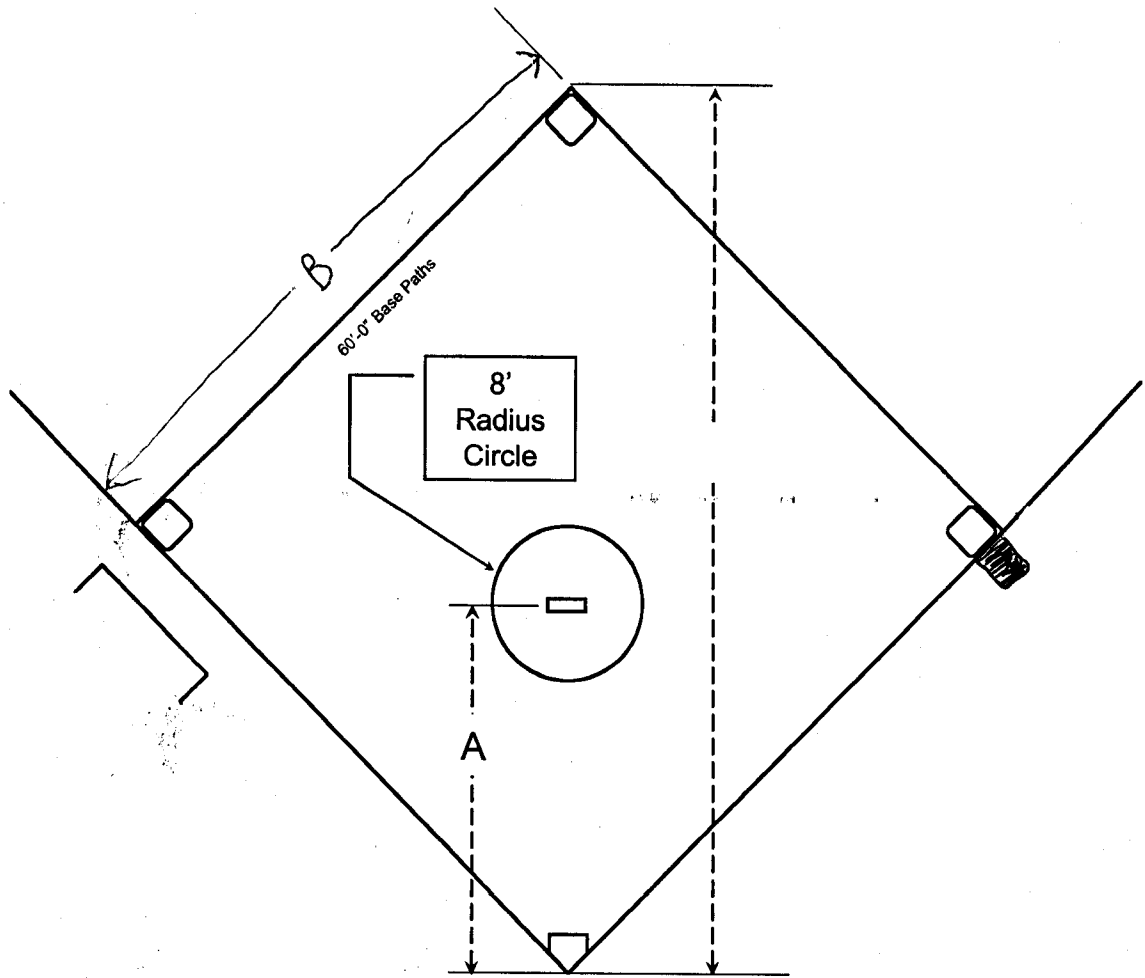


## **Field Set-up Instructions (Home Team)**

1. Put all bases in properly. Orange base at first base should be placed in foul territory.
2. Put in pitchers plate (use tape measure to verify proper distance) See chart for distance.
3. Get out chalk liner, tape measure, string, spike, hammer, and batters box template (if used).
4. Put stake in ground at point of home plate. Unroll string to the grass behind first base & pull tight. Line will go right through middle of base.
5. Line field starting from the grass toward home plate stopping 3 feet from home plate.
6. Take string from outfield and move it across infield to 3<sup>rd</sup> base. Line field with foul line on the dugout side. Roll up string.
7. Take tape measure to pitchers mound with stake. Stake in tape and use bottom of tape measures to help draw 8 ft. diameter circle. Use chalk liner to line circle.
8. Place batters box template in place and line batters box. If no template (7'long x 3'wide 6" from plate) (See Diagram).
9. Place lining supplies back in Field Box.
10. After the game the home team will rake the pitchers mound and batters box areas. Return all bases and pitchers plate to Field Box. Be sure to lock both locks.
11. Both teams will clean their dugout areas.
