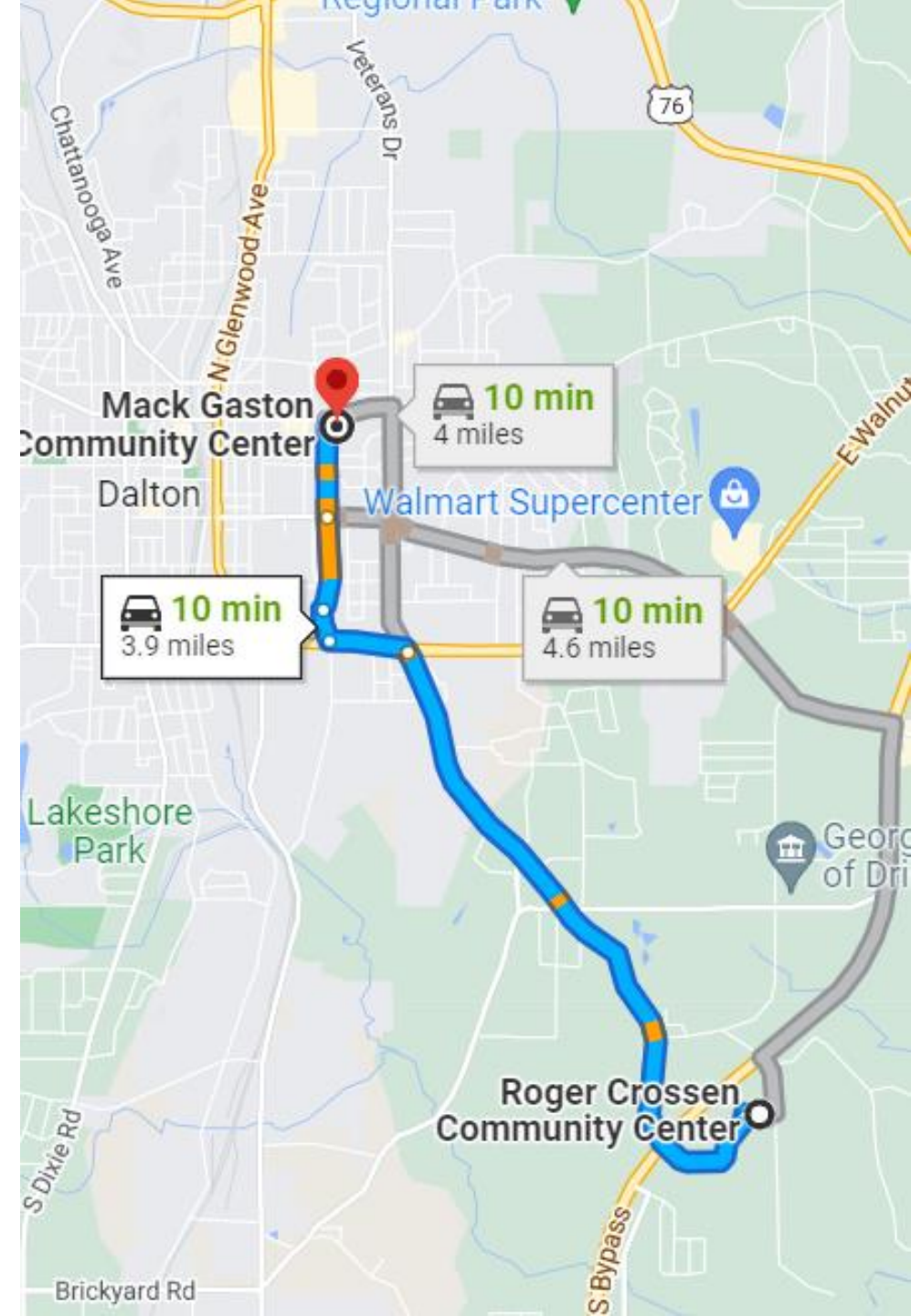
# LOCATION MAP

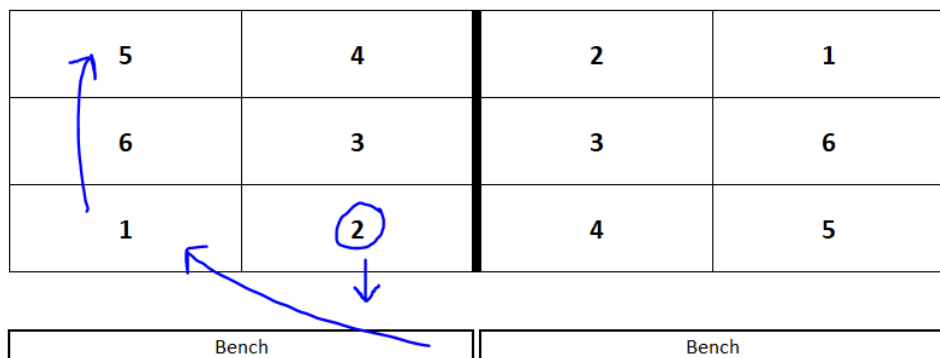

# TOURNAMENT RULES

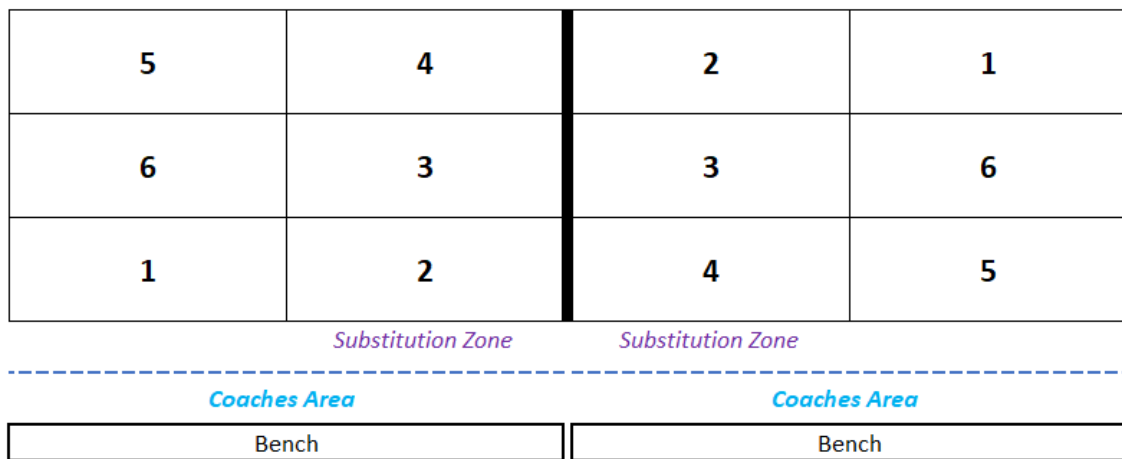
- Officials – Two certified officials for each game
  - Line judges
- League Rules vs GRPA Rules
- Matches
  - Best two of three sets
  - Third set will be played to 15
- Warm Up
  - 3 or 5 minutes
  - Coin toss to determine service/receive and side

# TOURNAMENT RULES – 10 & UNDER SPECIFICS



- When the receiving team gains service, they must rotate their first server in from the bench.
- Definition of snake rotation: Standard clockwise rotation. Player from position 2 moves out to bench and player from bench enters position 1 to serve.
  - See example 1
- If a player is not being played in a set, **they must sit in the stands with their parent/guardian.** They cannot sit on the bench unless they are in the lineup for that set.
  - To avoid players sitting away from the team, players that are **not** playing in a set must sit in chairs that are marked with BLUE tape. Coaches will also be required to notify scorekeeper and officials of any players that are not playing in a set. Failure to notify the score table and officials will lead to loss of point for out of rotation.
- NOTE: If a player gets injured on the court, the player comes out of the game and they rotate one player in from bench. The player rotated in will lose their service position, but no points are lost. Once the injured player is replaced the team who has service keeps service.
- There is no limit on the amount of serves a single player can serve. Some league rules require a player rotate after 5 successful serves. This does NOT apply to GRPA tournaments.

# TOURNAMENT RULES – 12 & 14 UNDER SPECIFICS

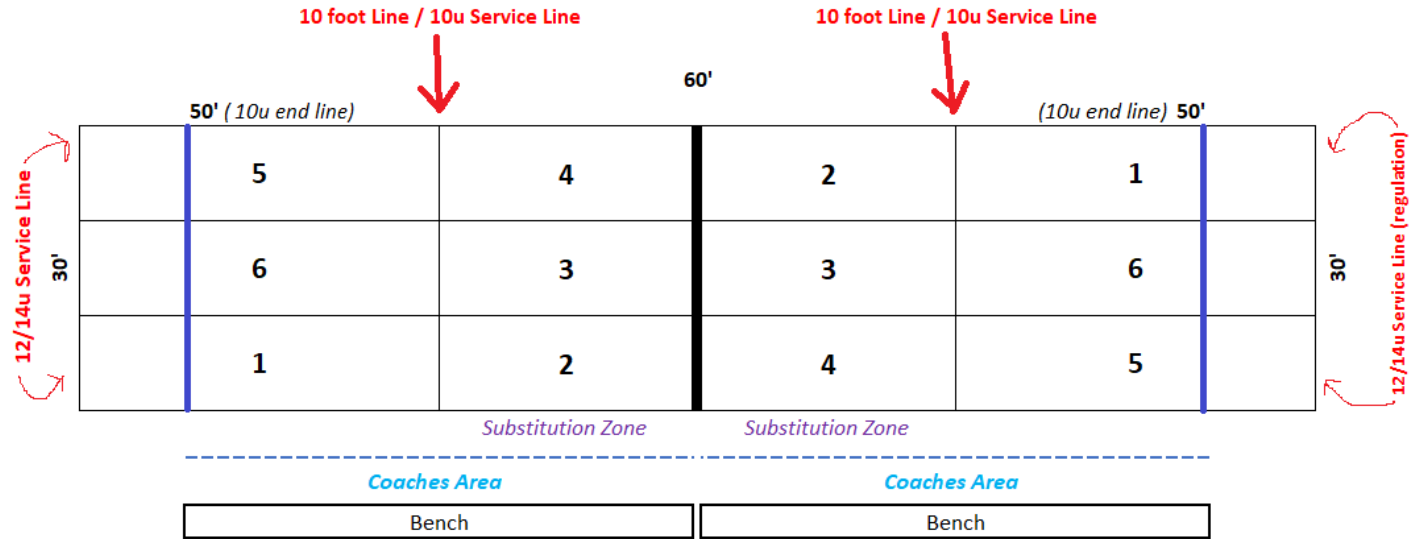


- Substitution – refer to USAV Official Rules for more detail.
  - Player Substitutions
    - Must be carried out within substitution zone; between the 10-foot line and the net on the team’s side. This will be enforced. Players can not run on and off the court without properly being substituted.
    - Max substitutions per set per team is eighteen (18).
    - Players may **only** substitute for one player per set.
      - EXAMPLE: #1 substitutes for #4 during the first set, #1 can only be substituted by #4.
  - Libero Replacements – *Jersey must be a different color than rest of the team*
    - Libero replacements are not counted as substitutions. They are unlimited but there must be a completed rally between two replacements.
    - A libero may **ONLY** replace a back-row player.
    - Only take place while the ball is out of play and before the whistle of service.
    - All replacements must be recorded by the Libero Tracker on the Libero Control
- Player Rotation: GHSA rotation
  - When a receiving team gains service, they must rotate to their first server. A team cannot start a service without rotating; unless they are the first serving team of the set.

# COURT SPECS

Please be aware that net heights may vary from your league play to tournament play.

- 10u – **This is not up for discussion or negotiation. The below specifications are listed in the GRPA manual and will be enforced.**
  - Net Height – 6'
  - Court size – 50'x30x (smaller than regulation)
  - Service line – players can serve UP TO the 10' line
    - Players can serve overhand or underhand
- 12u & 14 U –
  - Net Height – 7' 5"
  - Court size – regulation 60' x 30'
  - Service line – Regulation
  - Players can serve overhand or underhand
